

**ROBERT RAUSCHENBERG**

**Biographical Information**

- 1925 Born in Port Arthur, Texas
- 1947 Studied at the Académie Julian; Paris, France
- 1947–48 Studied at the Kansas City Art Institute, Kansas
- 1948–49 Studied at Black Mountain College; Asheville, North Carolina, under Josef Albert. Met Cunningham and John Cage.
- 1949–52 Studied at the Art Students League in New York
- 1952–53 Traveled to Europe and North Africa with Cy Twombly
- 1953 Met Jasper Johns who became a great influence on his work. Shared a neighboring studio.
- 1962 Made first lithograph at Universal Limited Art Editions in West Islip, New York
- 1964 Won Grand Prize in Painting at the Venice Biennale; Venice, Italy
- 1966 Experimented with electronics in his art
- 1970 Created the first Earth Day poster
- 1984 Began “The Rauschenberg Overseas Culture Interchange”
- 1990 Started The Rauschenberg Foundation, a non-profit entity devoted to projects that will increase public awareness about subjects of vital interest to the artist  
Created the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary Earth Day poster
- 2008 Died in Captiva, Florida
